Terry L. Jones is the founder of SYNCOM Management Company, Inc. and a general partner in SYCOM II, SYNCOM III and SYNCOM IV. Since joining SYNCOM in 1978, Jones has led the company to continuously meet its mission of providing early-stage growth capital primarily to entrepreneurs and companies that positively impact the minority community.

Under Jones' leadership SYNCOM's expertise and targeted approach within the rapidly developing communications sector has consistently produced competitive market rates of return for our investors, while creating significant wealth for our portfolio companies' management and other stakeholders. Currently, SYNCOM manages a group of telecommunications venture capital funds that have capital in excess of \$225 million.

Mr. Jones joined in 1978 and is a member of the board of directors of a number of Syncom portfolio companies and other corporations, including Radio One, Inc., Iridium Satellite, LLC, TV One, LLC and the Southern African Enterprise Development Fund, a presidential appointment. He is also a member of the Board of Trustees of Spellman College in Atlanta, Georgia.

Prior to joining Syncom in 1978, Mr. Jones lived and worked in Nairobi, Kenya where he was a co-founder and Vice President of Kiambere Savings and Loan, and a Lecturer at the University of Nairobi. He also worked as a Senior Electrical Engineer for Westinghouse Aerospace and Litton Industries.

Mr. Jones received a B.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from Trinity College, a M.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from George Washington University and a MBA from the Harvard University Graduate School of Business Administration
