**Bajo la Capucha: El Mundo de la Tortura (Under the Hood: A Voyage into the World of Torture)** Friday, 6/4/10 – Every day, around the world, prisoners are tortured. Some are guilty, many are innocent, but for all the scars never heal. A gripping look at the history of torture includes harrowing firsthand accounts from detainees in the War on Terror.
